Parents of pediatric patients are allowed to stay the night.

Meals are not provided for visitors. Drinks and snacks are available in the waiting room.

Family members are encouraged to rest comfortably at home to be ready for your discharge, which is expected to be around 9 am.

Bring all your routine medications in their original prescription bottles.

• Our nurses will administer your pain medication and other medications as prescribed by your physician.
